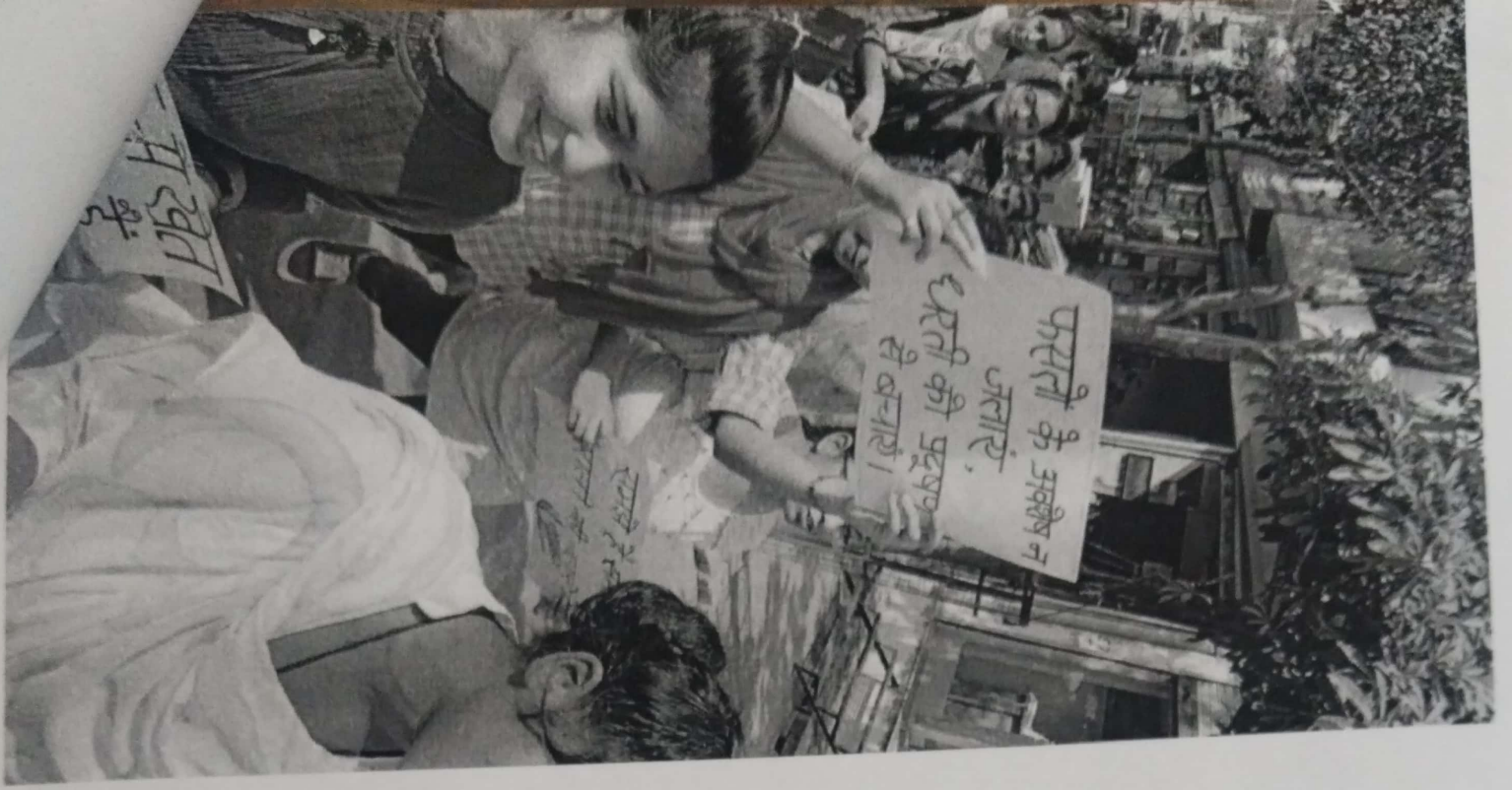

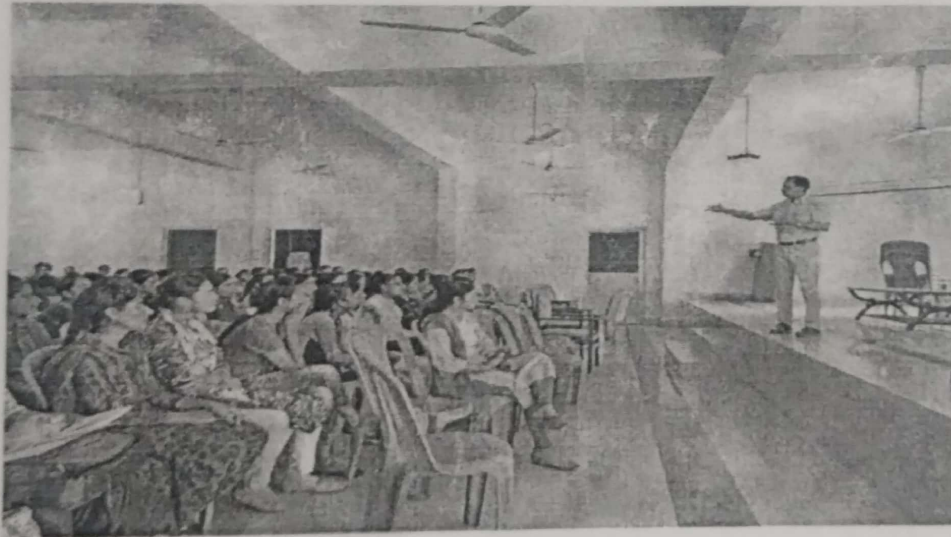


REPORT ON JAL SHAKTI ABHIYAN

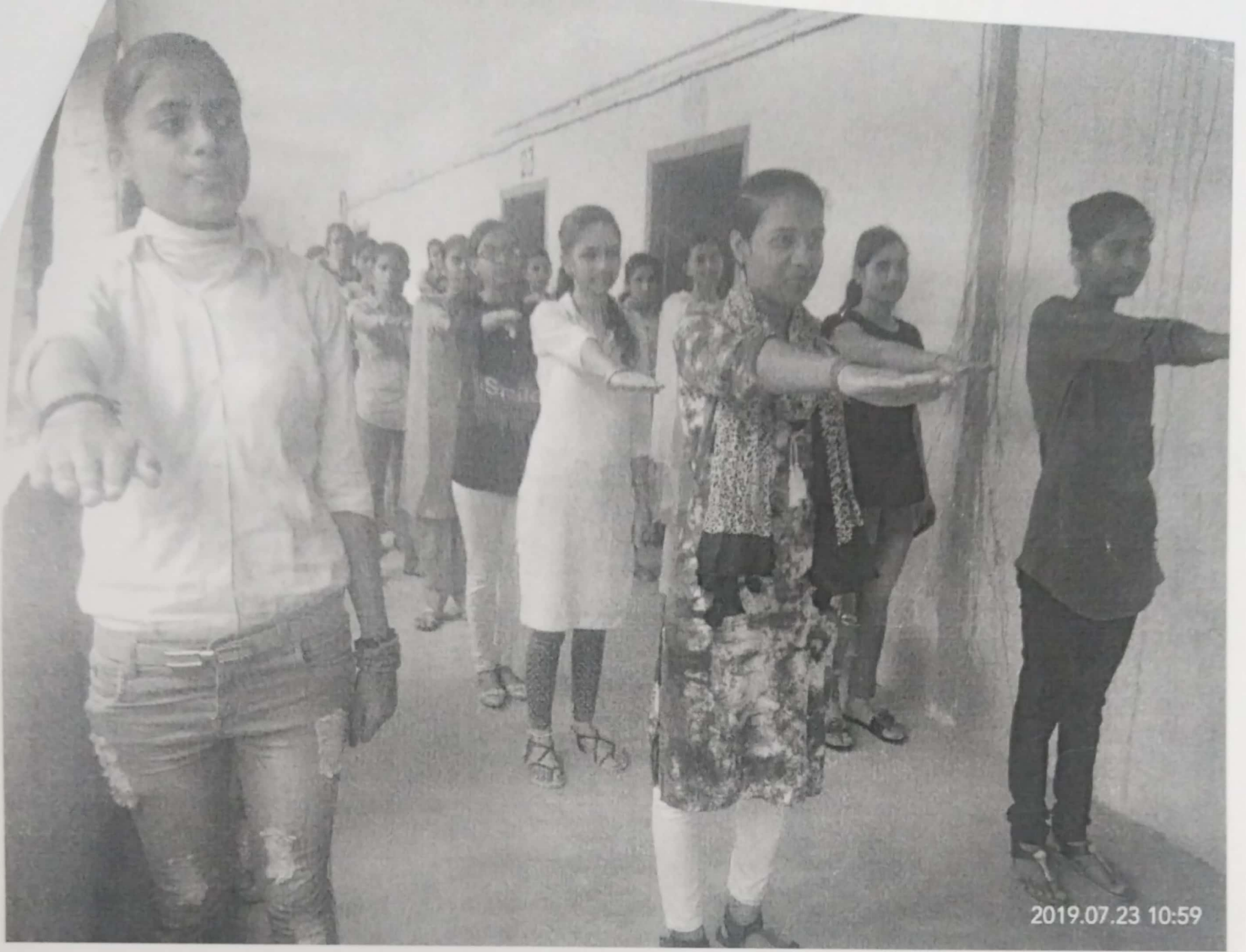




REPORT-SHARM DAAN

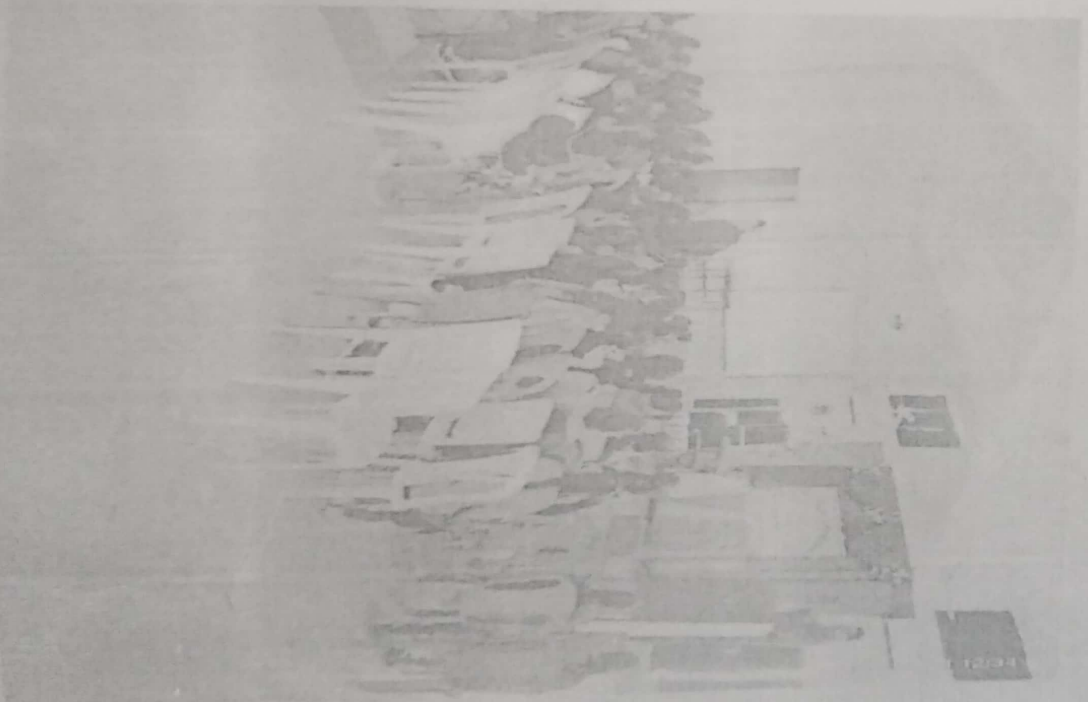
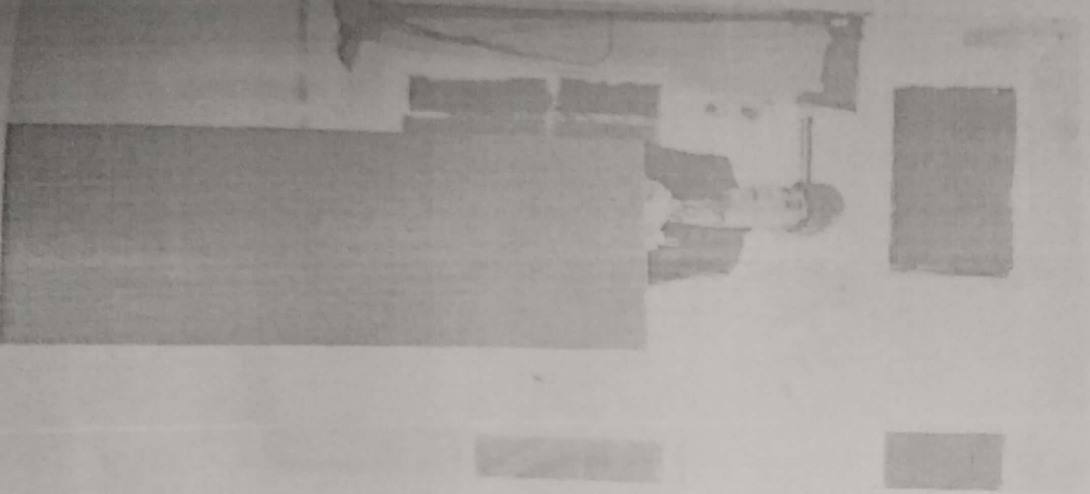
Day 1, Saturday, February 02, 2019.

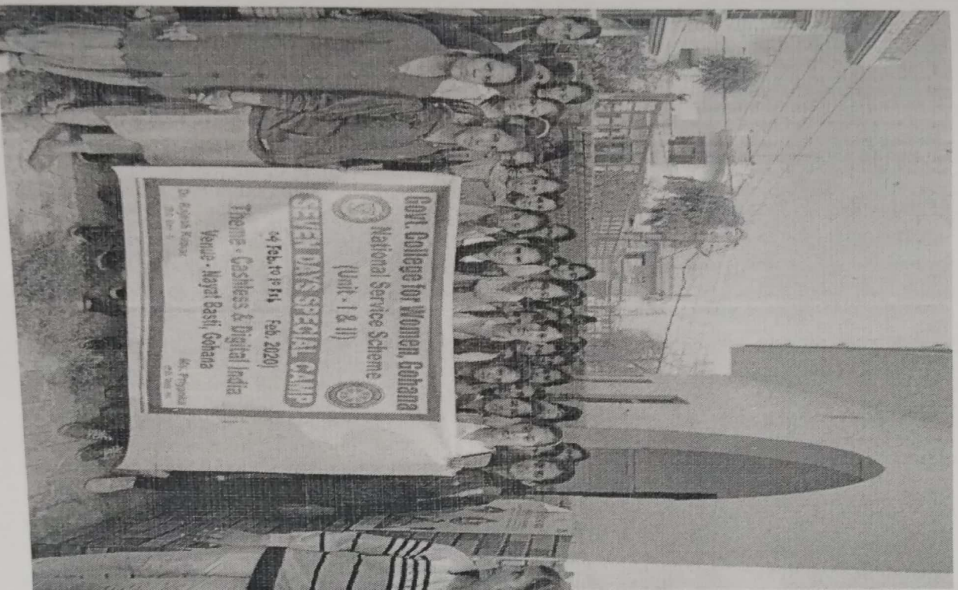

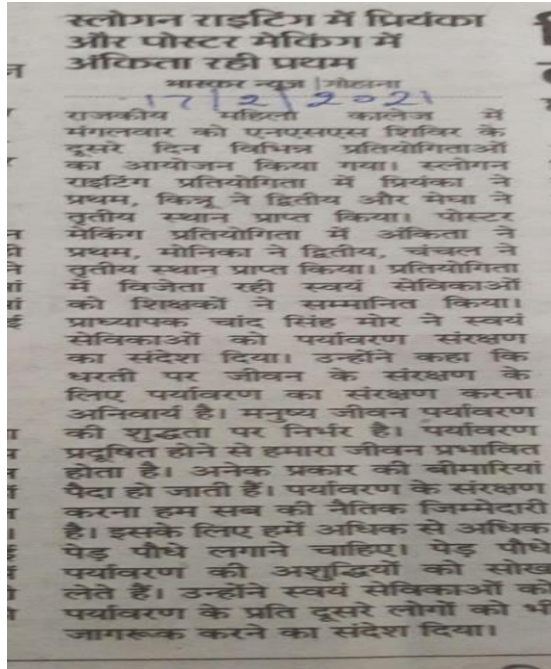
Day 2, Tuesday, February 16, 2021

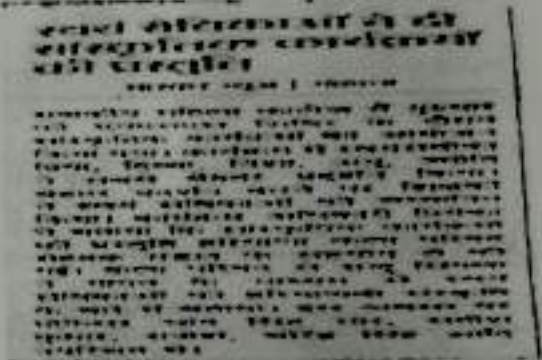
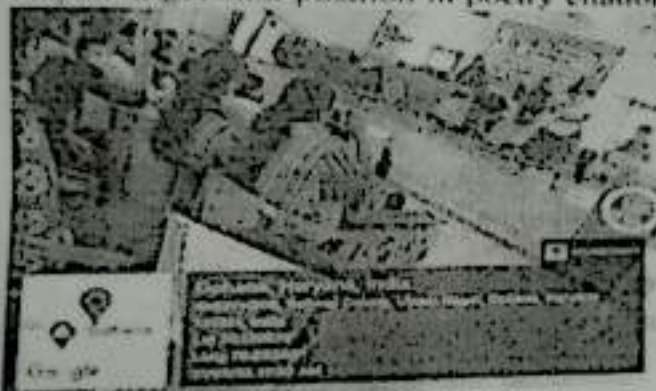
Seven Day special camp was conducted at Nayat Basti, Gohana from 13.03.2022-19.03.2022 by NSS unit I and Unit II.

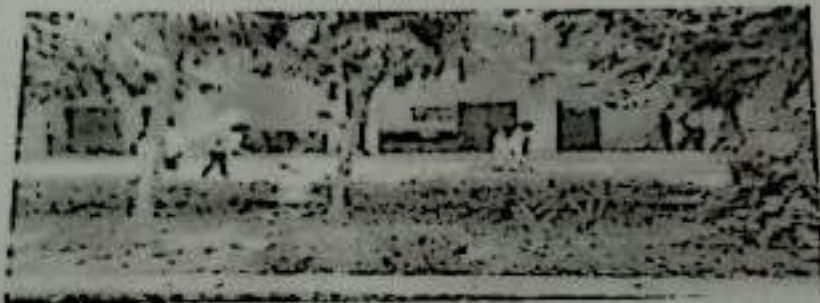


lecture on importance of environment in our life. And NSS volunteers celebrate the Holi fest by playing with colours, singing and dancing.

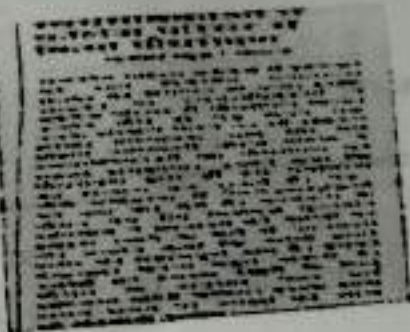
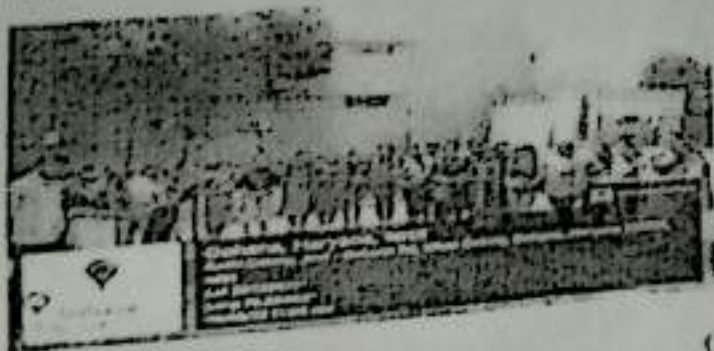


Day 7
